Comments: During the renewal inspection, The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that one eligible staff member indicated in their binder having completed all 10 hours but only had printed certificates for 9 hours of professional learning in the past licensing year. All eligible staff members must complete 10 hours of professional learning in the past licensing year. The administrator shared that they will have a discussion with the staff member in question regarding the 1 hour certificate that is missing.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that one staff member is missing a copy of the Introduction to ECE course certificate in their file. Training qualification certificates and diplomas must be inserted in the staff member's files. The administrator immediately inserted a copy of the Introduction to ECE course certificate of the staff member in question in their file. Deficiency is now compliant			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (c) staff member records that include (iii) a description of the staff member's duties and responsibilities.	24(1)(c)(iii)	May 15, 2025	May 08, 2025
Comments: During the renewal inspection, The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that one staff member is missing the description and responsibilities in their file. The description of duties and responsibilities must be included in the staff member's file. The administrator immediately inserted a copy of the description of duties and responsibilities of the staff member in question in their file. Deficiency is now compliant			
28(2) An operator of a licensed facility shall carry out emergency evacuation and fire drills monthly.	28(2)	May 15, 2025	May 08, 2025
Comments: During the renewal inspection, The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills had not been conducted for the month of November. The monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills must be completed. The administrator shared that the emergency evacuation and fire drills had been conducted in November, but this information was forgotten to be recorded. The administrator immediately added the missing information. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: During the renewal inspection, The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the monthly review and maintenance plan on all stationary equipment had not been completed for the month of October, November and December. The monthly review and maintenance plan must be completed on all stationary equipment. The administrator shared that the staff member's review and conduct maintenance of the outdoor play area before each use in the morning and the afternoon. The administrator immediately added the missing information. Deficiency is now compliant			
39(3) Despite paragraph (2)(b), medications administered in cases of anaphylactic shock shall not be stored in a locked space.	39(3)	May 08, 2025	May 08, 2025
Comments: During the renewal inspection, The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that an EpiPen in a classroom that was not easily accessible, as it was stored in a locked box with a code. Medications used for anaphylactic shock must be stored safely but easily accessible. The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the staff member regarding the EpiPen that must be easily accessible, the staff member immediately stored the EpiPen easily accessible, out of reach of the children. Deficiency is now compliant			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	May 15, 2025	May 08, 2025
Comments: During the renewal inspection, The Quality Assurance Monitor observed 3 water bottles that were not labelled with the name of the child in one classroom. Personal belongings must be labelled with the name of the child. The staff member immediately labelled the 3 water bottles with the name of the child. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for the renewal inspection.

During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor is present during snack time, indoor play, lunch, nap time and outdoor play.

During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed 1 expired medication in two classrooms stored in the locked medication box. The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the staff members that all expired medication should be returned to the parents, and that new medication should be requested if needed.
