During the visit, the Quality Assurance monitor verified:

- if all required documents were posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility,
- outdoor play area
- child guidance

New staff members were entered in the system.

QA monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding incident logs/incident reports. The system to make the parents sign was not recommended by the QA monitor. Since incident logs/incident reports are individualized for each child, they should be kept confidential. To protect confidentiality, parents should not be able to see other children's reports. QA monitor recommends that all educators keep the reports under their clipboards and make parents signed upon arrival, instead of making parents go through all incident report outside the classroom.
