The Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that staff members were discussion choosing some children to go to a car dealership for a photo-op with the vehicle that was provided to the facility. The Quality Assurance Monitor questioned the staff member's in questions if the parents had signed a consent form for the outing. The operator informed the Quality Assurance Monitor that each parent had signed a consent form for outings and transportation. The Quality Assurance Monitor informed the operator that a consent stating where the children are going, with the date and time is needed when an outing occurs. The operator decided to cancel the outing.
