Comments:  Deficiency is now compliant. There was a closed bottle of benadryl in a box on a high shelf in one of the classrooms. The manager moved this to a locked closet during my inspection. Medications are generally kept in the kitchen aside from the epi-pen kept accessible.					
General Comments					
At the start of the inspection the children were eating and preparing for transition to nap. There was a supervised play area available just outside the classroom with books, crafts, and toys, for the few children who weren't able to nap for the whole time.					
Documentation of learning was observed including artworks on the wall and in learning stories written on the walls. Educators sat on the floor and at tables and played with children. Educators maintained patience with children, encouraged them to use their words to resolve conflicts with their friends in the class, and prompted them to be gentle with hands and feet while playing with friends. Educators encouraged as much independence as possible with skills for independence such as dressing for outdoors but were available to help when needed. Educators were observed regularly performing headcounts of the children in their group.					
Classrooms were stocked with varied and ample supplies for play including: arts and crafts supplies, costumes, blocks & building supplies, toys and play stations for pretend play, and books.					
The children rotated in small groups for outdoor play. There were varied options available for play including digging tools, a play structure, a playhouse, a tricycle, and wheeled toys. Educators positioned themselves well to maintain sightlines both outdoors and in classrooms.					
All observed files for children and staff were well-maintained and contained up-to-date information.
