At the time of the follow-up inspection, licensing staff noted that the afterschool children and staff moved back to the classroom which has a bathroom inside the classroom and therefore easier for the educators to allow the

children go to the washroom more independently.

When licensing staff entered the afterschool program space, it was noted that the musty smell was still present however, not nearly as strong as the day of the initial licensing renewal inspection.

While reviewing files on the day of the follow-up inspection, all files (children and staff) were complete with all of the required information.

Licensing staff also noted that all of the required information was posted on the communication board.

Licensing staff observed the children engage in a number of activities during the inspection visit. One group of children played in a small tent that an educator brought in for the children to play with! Another group of children played with cars while another group of children sat at a table and coloured with crayons and marker.

When the educators arrived at the centre a child was feeling "down" as they did not have a good day at school. Their educators were very empathetic towards the children and offered compassionate and encouraging words to help cheer them up. Well done!

All educators engaged with the children, at all times, and at the child's level. Well done!
