The younger afterschoolers were drawing and playing house at the beginning of their afternoon. The educator allowed flexibility to expand on their imaginative play and children could move the gym mats and tables/chairs over to the area where they were building their house.

The routine also allowed for children to eat snack as they became hungry.

The educator remained engaged with the children and helped the children draw and was also teaching the children to knit.

Children were provided with time warnings before transitions.

When the older afterschoolers arrived, children could choose what activity they wanted to do or if they wanted to

have snack. Children played with Lincoln Logs, were making crafts with scissors, paper and glue and played on the gym mats. Some children also continued to work on their Lego creations that they can put on the shelf at the end of the day to save.

When parents arrived at the door for pickup, the educator brought all children to the foyer to ensure proper supervision at all times. 15-minute checks were also completed to track attendance throughout the afternoon.
