General Comments

The preschool programs at the YMCA are now sharing the Kiddies College, fenced in, outdoor playground. A schedule has been created so that one preschool program utilizes the shared outdoor playground at one time.

First Aid certification course is scheduled for mid-May for those educators who are needing to re-certify.

Child files are now complete with all of the necessary documents needed to meet regulation according to the Early Childhood Services Act.

Licensing staff observed wonderful child guidance during the follow-up inspection on April 26, 2021. The educator was engaged with the children at all times. The educator also read a story that one of the children brought in. The educator also brought in some "mad-libs" and a joke book for the children to explore. The children were excited about these new books.

During the follow-up inspection on April 26, 2021 there were invitations of play set up for the children to engage in upon their arrival. The invitations of play included the following: Checkers, Snakes and Ladders, block play, Lego, and drawing/sketching in a scrap book (educator made for the children), and a table set up for "restaurant" dramatic play. When the children engaged with the dramatic play invitation they incorporated the babies by pretending to feed the babies cupcakes. Wonderful invitations of play!

One of the children brought in a book from home and the educator read this story while the children engaged in play and listened to the story. The educator was very expressive while reading the story to the children which the children enjoyed. After reading the story to the children, the educator went around to each group to engage with the children playing in different areas in the room. All of the children engaged with at least one of the invitations of play that were set up.

At 3:30pm the children went to the gym for some play time. While in the gym, the children played toilet tag, fishes and whales, and rock, paper, scissors tag. After the games of tag the educator put music on for the children to enjoy for the last few minutes of their gym time.

A set of walkie talkies would be very useful for the educators to reach a floater staff when needed instead of texting a manager as it is quicker and the attention will always be on the children while in the classroom or other rooms in the YMCA.
