General Comments
<p>On the morning of the monitoring visit, the children in the Jones Room were participating in different stations around the room. The educators had set out 5 centres that included playdough, a bird feeder craft, painting, and a pipe cleaner craft. Children could choose where they went and could switch later on. Educators were very patient with the children and explained the expectations very clearly for each station. They also showed compassion and empathy when children were upset and enthusiasm when the children wanted to show them their creations.</p> <p>As per the Public Health report in June, the walls still require some attention. The walls need to be repaired so they can be easily cleaned and sanitized.</p> <p>In the Exp. Room, children were having some free time when I arrived. Many children were talking with their peers and trying to decide what to do next and others were reading and playing with pop-its. The room requires the materials to be organized and replenished. The children grew restless as the free time continued. The tables did not have any choices set out on them. The educator did set out a banner after some time for the children. Some materials that were set aside for this craft were brought out from the storage closet- streamers, glitter glue, and paint. Educators displayed good child guidance practices such as kind reminders, low and calm voice and clear expectations.</p> <p>Please make sure that absence codes are used to indicate the reason for a child's absence.</p>
