The educators were kind and engaging with the children. Lots of positive encouragement towards the children, whether it be while putting their snowsuits on, mealtime or playtime. All classrooms had lots of learning activities and arts and crafts on the walls. The outdoor play space has been divided into four sections and the groups rotate through the week. The outdoor play spaces are well maintained, and the kids still have easy access to theirs toys and climbers.

The two's were engaged in dancing, listening to music, playing with construction tools, trucks and race tracks. In the afternoon, the three's had different activity stations and they rotated in small groups. The four's were doing arts and crafts and playing in the house. The younger infants were playing with toys and on their foam mats and the older infants were doing puzzles, dancing and singing.

All the children seem happy, lots of laughter around the centre, the toys and materials are clean and in good repair, the facility is following all covid-19 guidelines.

\*I observed the children in the 2-year-old class using the potty in the classroom with no privacy and near the tables and play area. As discussed, as per licensing regulation 38(1)-38(4) and section 9.2.4 of the Operator Manual, children must have access to a washroom. For the privacy of the children, each toileting space is separated by using curtains, wall partitions and/or doors. All toileting activities, such as use of potty chairs, take place in a designated washroom facility and not in play areas. Effective immediately, for privacy and sanitary reasons, the 2-year-old class must use the washroom at the end of the hall.
