## **General Comments**

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility on June 28th, 2022 at 9:30am to conduct the license renewal inspection.

The children were engaged in outdoor play activities on the lovely, naturally shaded outdoor play space. Licensing staff observed the children playing in the wooden outdoor classroom, throwing flying discs, engaging in dramatic play, climbing on the little tykes climbing structure, climbing on the dome and balancing and jumping on the tractor tire, as well as, the wooden balance beam.

Licensing staff observed Arabic writing on the wooden outdoor classroom and when licensing staff asked the educator the meaning of the words, the educator replied that she wrote the names of the educators. The educator also relayed to licensing staff that the children expressed that the enjoyed seeing their educators' names translated in Arabic at the entrance of the wooden classroom. This is a wonderful example of Diversity and Social Responsibility facet of the New Brunswick Curriculum Framework.

The children were given two water breaks while licensing staff were observing the children outdoors.

## General Comments

The educators were observed using positive guidance strategies throughout the license inspection visit.

While licensing staff was observing on the outdoor playground, it was noted that the climbing dome did not have 6.6 feet (2.0 metres) of protective surfacing surrounding the climbing dome. According to 33(2) of the Early Childhood Services Act, "stationary equipment in the outdoor play area shall be surrounded by a protective surfacing and installed according to the manufacturer's instructions." The manufacturer's manual for the dome, located on the outdoor play ground, states that the equipment should be placed on level, well-drained ground, not less than 6.6 ft (2.0 metres) from any structure or obstruction such as a fence, garage, house, overhanging branches, laundry lines or electrical wires. Please ensure that there is the recommended protective surfacing surrounding the climbing dome according to the manufacturer's manual.

The manufacturer's manual also states that domes are not recommended for commercial use.

While inspecting the emergency fire escape route walkway from the upper level of the licensed facility, licensing staff noted animal feces beside the patio stones leading to the stairs that take you down to the outdoor play area. Licensing staff also noted that the railing on the stairs leading down to the outdoor play area was noticeably wobbly and loose. Please ensure that this area is kept free of animal feces and the railing is secured to maintain the safety of children.

Also, licensing staff noted that the tarp covering the large sandbox, located on the outdoor playground, was not large enough to completely cover the sandbox. Please ensure that the sandbox is completely covered to deter animals from defecating in it.

Licensing staff also noted that the light fixture, located in the two year old classroom, was not covered by the glass shade and a light bulb was missing in one of the sockets. Please ensure that the shades are put back on the light sockets and a light bulb is put back in the socket.

While inspecting the basement area, licensing staff noted cleaning supplies that were behind a door with a hook and eye, however; all cleaning supplies and toxic materials are required to be secured behind a locked cabinet or closet to maintain the safety of the children.

Most water bottles were labelled with the intended child's name. Please remember to label all water bottles with the intended child's name.

While inspecting staff files, licensing staff noted that one staff signed off that they have read and understood their job responsibilities, however; the job description is not in the staff's file. Please ensure that all staff files are complete with all required documentation.

While inspecting staff files, licensing staff noted that one staff does not have a completed Social Development check. Please ensure that all staff files are complete with all required documentation.
