General Comments

Upon my arrival to the facility, some children were still arriving for the day. Parents were granted access to the facility and I observed two parents remain for several minutes in the classroom and this was welcomed by the educator.

The child guidance practices displayed were kind, patient and nurturing. Children were given reminders, time transitions and support when needed. Educators played with children outside and I observed them engaging in the imaginative play of the children, singing, and dancing. Children were given water breaks to ensure that they briefly stopped playing to have a drink. Educators worked as a team and engaged with all the children. The outdoor materials were plentiful and I saw balls, trucks, ride on toys, scoops, tea pots and blocks. Materials were accessible to children for them to choose. Educators also brought out additional items from the shed and set out chalk for the children as well.

The routine was smooth from free play to snack and then outdoor time.

All educators shared with me what the children are interested in and it is evident through conversation that they understand the curriculum and are implementing it daily. I look forward to seeing more documentation added to the rooms as the year progresses. Older documentation from March and April can be removed and new webs and learning stories added.

The three's room has a recent learning story from late August 2022 and the theme of apples and fall is evident through recent art and displays on the board.

All three rooms have ample materials, toys and art supplies stored on low, open shelves for children to access.

I observed diaper changing and proper procedures were followed including the child thoroughly washing their hands for an appropriate length of time (they sang the ABC's together.) The educator used the opportunity to talk to the child about all the sounds they were hearing.

I did not visit with the afterschoolers today.
