<p>General Comments</p> <p>Upon arrival to the facility the children were outside. The 4 year olds were on the stage practicing their graduation songs and appeared to know them well. The other children were playing in different areas of the outdoor play space which included but not limited to a play structure, lemonade stand, a mud kitchen, play house, ride on toys, and basket ball net. There is also a large sand area and planters for the children to plant things in. The educators were engaged with the children throughout the morning. Music was playing in the outdoor play space and the educators were having fun dancing with the children.</p> <p>The educators were observed as kind and caring with the children. A child had fallen off a log and had hurt themselves. The educator allowed the child to express themselves, validated the child's feelings and asked if they could check the area that the child had hurt. An ice pack was applied and reassurance and hugs were given to the child. The child was allowed to stay with the educator until they were ready to get up and play again.</p> <p>After outdoor play, the entrance back into the facility was group by group and at different times. The children washed their hands, sat at the table while their lunches were being heated. The educator then would read a book to the children. The children eat their lunch and then two and three year old age groups go to the nap room to sleep. The four year olds will go to the library upstairs and outside. Once the children wake up and have snack, one of the educators will do a yoga class with them as they do every Wednesday.</p> <p>Documentation of the children's learning is evident.. Artwork is displayed throughout the classrooms and the children have portfolios with artwork and learning stories in them. The children's photos were displayed by a macrame frame and photos of the children were displayed in many of the classrooms.</p> <p>Staff and children's files were complete. All documentation was easily verified for licensing.</p>
