### General Comments

Upon Licensing staff arrival to conduct the renewal inspection, the Educator and children were in the Lego room playing.

The indoor space was clean and organized. Material such as puzzles, board games, books, art supplies, loose play pieces, K'nex, dolls with accessories and mini hockey sticks were in good condition. The cubby room had a large shelf for shoes, hooks for belongings and a space for water bottles and sunscreen. Later in the visit, the children cleaned up the Lego and began to play mini stick hockey. The Educator was actively engaged with the children and laughter and cheering was heard. Before afternoon snack, the table was cleaned, and proper handwashing was observed. Once finished with snack, the children were observed cleaning up their lunch bags and getting ready to finish their day outside. Sunscreen was applied, water bottles were filled up.

The outdoor play space was fully fenced with plenty of natural shade. Play material such as a large connect four game, wooden balance beams, a ninja climbing line, as well as a spike ball net were in good condition. Extra sport gear and balls were organized in bins under the deck. Two large soccer nets were set up and the children were observed playing with the Educator. Positive words of encouragement such as "Great job, buddy!" and "Way to go!" were heard.

Child and staff files were in order, evacuation plans were posted, monthly fire drills are being completed and daily attendance was recorded.

Licensing staff recommends for renewal.
