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General Comments Licensing staff arrived in the morning to conduct a monitoring inspection. The children were getting ready for a field trip to the Nashwaaksis Field House on chartered School District buses. While there they walked the trails and played games in the field. They posted a sign for parents on the door letting everyone know where they were. It rained really hard in the morning, but the school bus returned in time for the children to avoid the worst of the rain. They returned to the recreation centre where the program is situated. The children are divided into older and younger afterschool groups, and they each have their own classroom upstairs. Everyone ate lunch at the tables in their classroom and then they made paper plate frogs for their craft activity. This week's summer camp theme is Colour week. Brilliant Labs came this afternoon to do science experiments with each group separately. Today everyone will play in the gym because of the rain otherwise they would play outside. The program supplies an afternoon snack and today it is waffles, syrup and bananas. Tuesdays and Thursday everyone swims at the Henry Park public pool. The staff receive a week of training before they begin the summer programs, and they are really knowledgeable and well prepared to work with the children. All staff complete the Commit to Kids online training to help keep the children and themselves safe. They were very engaged in the children's play, and they worked hard to settle moods and teach the children good self-regulation skills. Staff proactively managed behaviours and were kind, consistent and firm with their child guidance. They communicate with each other with walkie talkies which makes communication on field trips and bathroom supervision in their multi-level building easier. The building is locked and has a doorbell, the entryway has space for the children's belongings, and the parent board is complete and posted in the entryway. Everything was clean and newly painted, the office has been re-organized, and the downstairs craft room looked great. All staff files and five child files were reviewed and found to be up to date. The program is running very smoothly, the transitions are calm and well managed, and the atmosphere is pleasant and enjoyable for everyone.
