General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the facility just before the children and educators left for the splashpad at Wilmot Park.

Licensing staff drove to Wilmot Park to observe the activities for the morning. While one group played at the splashpad while the other groups went to the park; after 20 minutes, the groups switched.

The children and educators transitioned very smoothly from the bus to the park and then from the park to the bus to go back to the club.

Educators were observed engaging in play with the children the entire inspection.

Only positive child guidance was used during the inspection visit. The entire morning was very organized, and the educators used walkie talkies to communicate. The flow of the afternoon at the club was also very organized as the children changed rooms to engage in multiple activities.

While inspecting the indoor environment, licensing staff asked the Program Manager where they store their cleaning supplies. The Program Manager relayed to licensing staff that they store most toxic materials in the boiler room which is locked with a lock and key. The Program Manager also told licensing staff that they store some cleaning supplies in the kitchen which has a child lock on the cabinet. Licensing staff relayed to the Program Manager that all cleaning supplies and toxic materials are to be stored in a cabinet or closet secured by a lock and key. The Program Manager moved all toxic materials to the boiler room until a lock with a key is purchased.
