Children were having snack upon arrival. The morning snack was cantaloupe, honeydew melon and rice cakes. After snack the children got ready for outdoor play time. The infants played on the slide and dug in the sandbox. The two- and four-year-old group played on the large swing and the climbing dome while the three-year-olds explored and played in the forest area. Children played outside until lunch was served. Today's lunch was chicken nuggets, fries, mashed potatoes, corn and milk. Although it is against regulations to have infants mixed with other children outside the hours of 8:30am-4:30pm, proper ratio was maintained during the visit. The operator stated that she had a conversation with the parents before moving the children to the new classroom.
