General Comments

Upon arrival I was screened and asked to sanitize my hands promptly. The center is following all COVID guidelines very well. When I arrived there were a couple of groups playing outside, and other groups were inside participating in some free play. There were sufficient materials available for the children in the classrooms. Children's work was displayed on the walls. The after school group had no school today and so they were attending the whole day. The school age children got a chance to tell each other about their weekends, and each child had a turn to talk while others listened. They seemed to really enjoy this activity. The groups take turns using the playground due to COVID guidelines, and the schedule seems to work well. After lunch some children were going outside while others nap. Programming is still being done daily in order to plan with the interests of the children in mind, adhering to the NB Curriculum Framework.

Staff files are well maintained and all required checks were up to date. The center meets the requirement for having at least 50% of educators with ECE. The outdoor area has lots of materials for the children to play with. There is adequate shade and various types of surfacing for the children to play on. The playground has large planters for the children to plant, and the plants have already been planted inside and they will transfer them outside when it is warm enough. As discussed, I suggest that the green carpet be replaced or removed due to it being ripped. Overall, the playground is maintained well.
