General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the facility at 9:30am. Upon arriving, the 2's classroom were outside and the other groups were inside engaging in free play activities. The infants were observed playing with blocks while the educator sat with them on the floor. The 3's classroom were engaged in free play at "stations". One group was observed playing with small colorful dinosaurs while others were coloring and playing with playdough. In the 4's classroom, the educators were observed preparing invitations to play while another educator read a book to the group of children.

When it was time to transition to the invitations to play in the 4's classroom, the educator prompted the children to choose a station to play in. The educators were observed engaging in the children's activities while supervising. An educator was heard asking questions to the children as they engaged in water play with glitter and multiple accessories. As some children appeared to lose interests in the stations, the educators encouraged the children to play with other materials. During this time, the 2's classrooms were playing outside with paint sticks, trucks and in the large sandbox. An educator was observed preparing a "flower painting" activity for the group. Various and sufficient outdoor play materials were observed on the playground.

Later, the 3's classroom was observed cleaning up before "circle time". Circle time is when the children and educators gather on a carpet to sing songs, read books, and talk as a group. The educators were observed helping the children clean up their toys and were heard praising them for cleaning up. The group proceeded to have circle time. After, the educators were observed changing diapers and washing the children's hands before serving lunch. All classrooms washed their hands, and the educators were observed sanitizing the tables before serving lunch. The educators supervised the children as they ate lunch. During this time, an educator from each room was observed preparing the beds for nap time.

The indoor environment was clean and well organized. The children's personal belongings were well stored and labelled. The washrooms were clean. Daily attendance was taken in each classroom. Recent artifacts and learning stories were observed. Various and sufficient indoor and outdoor materials were observed in all classrooms and both outdoor play areas. The educators were in touch with the children's needs and were observed kneeling to speak to the children. Please ensure that the replacement gate is installed between the
