General Comments

Monitoring visit performed - no compliances observed on the day of my visit. The administrator signed licensing staff on the visitor log.

Administrative records were reviewed - attendance was checked and new staff information. These records are all in order and neatly organized and securely stored in a file cabinet.

All cleaning solutions are stored locked. Sanitizing solution (a mixture of javix and water) is stored on a shelf out of reach of children but easily accessible for staff. This is an appropriate practice and does not need to be stored under lock and key. The javix only needs storage under lock and key and this was observed on the day of my visit. The sanitizing solution should be mixed daily for wiping down tables, door knobs etc.

All children were observed getting ready for outdoor play. It was a beautiful morning and children were enjoying a variety of outdoor experiences. Educators were observed engaged with children.

Evidence of program planning is taking place. Documentation of children's learning experiences are posted throughout the centre - in the hallways and in classrooms at children's eye level. It is purposefully planned and organized and meets the needs and interests of the children. I read oodles of recent learning stories posted in the classrooms. Past programming is also stored in binders. Educators documentation of children's play experiences reference the goals of the curriculum framework.

The Afterschool children are also in attendance for a second full week since the strike commenced on October 29th. This is a busy group and they have been writing letters to different businesses and asking some great questions. They have received feedback from Sobeys, the happy baker etc.

Today's yummy lunch was a beef, vegetable rice dish with apple sauce and milk.
