General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility during quiet time to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the infants were napping while other rooms were engaged in quiet time activities and preparing for afternoon snack. Proper hand washing was observed before the children sat down to eat. The children were served pineapple and crackers which reflects what was posted on the Menu for afternoon snack today.

In the 2-year-old classroom, one Educator sat with the children as they ate while the other Educator started to lay out snowsuits, hats and mittens. As the children finished eating, they were observed using the washroom before getting ready to go outside. The Educators played an action game as they got ready, "If you're ready for outside...stomp your boots". While outside, many children were observed playing in the sandbox. Children were seen using large spoons, shovels, mixing bowls and spatulas. The Educators were well spread out to ensure proper supervision. Later in the afternoon, an Educator walked over to the elementary school to meet the school aged children for end of day dismissal. Once they arrived back at the facility, they had snack. As they finished, the class was observed doing crossword puzzles, crafting and reading.

The classrooms have lots of natural light and other sources of soft lighting such as lamps and string lights. The classes use a monthly calendar to track and organize pre-planned activities. Webbing was also observed outside the classrooms. Current learning stories, family pictures and process art were posted throughout the facility. Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. Educators were attentive to the needs of the children and were actively engaged with the children, often playing games with them and singing songs together. Headcounts were observed as the children left the classroom to get ready in the hallway and again before going outside. Allergies are posted in each classroom and in the kitchen area.
