General Comments

When the children arrived to the facility, they had outdoor play time. The educators wanted to allow the children to move around and play after a full school day. The educators followed the interest of the children and noticed that the children were really enjoying playing outdoors so after the children went inside to wash their hands, everyone went back outside for snack. The snack today was sun chips, goldfish crackers and bananas.

In the outdoor play space, children participated in a number of different activities. Some children sat at the picnic tables and colored, some played in the sandbox, played on the swing set and others played ball hockey. Educators placed themselves around the space to ensure adequate supervision. Educators also made sure they retrieved toys from the shed to prevent children from going in.

There is no bulb in the light socket in the shed and one electrical outlet is missing the cover plate. Please add these to maintain the safety of the staff and children.

The indoor environment has an abundance of well-organized and accessible materials. There are board games, card games, art and coloring areas, Barbies and Lego as well as well-stocked dramatic play areas. There is also a reading area with comics and chapter books.

Fire drills were completed and recorded for September as well as the outdoor maintenance checklist.
