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**General Comments**

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the facility was engaged in quiet time activities. Today was a snow day, so the school age children were on site for a full day. The school age Educator was observed reading a chapter book out loud to a small group of children while others were observed drawing and coloring at the tables.

The indoor environment was bright and welcoming. The classrooms offered soft lighting through string lights and lamps. There have been several positive changes since the last Monitoring Inspection. A variety of new light cubes, emotion discs and colorful sensory tubes were observed in each classroom. In the Junior Infants the Educators were observed sitting with the infants as they explored the different play materials in the classroom. They have been celebrating the Lunar New Year. The room was decorated with lanterns, and the infants explored a Lunar New Year themed sensory table. A new board has been added on the wall with speech bubbles to display the infant's vocabulary. The Educators were heard praising the infants as they learned new words.

In the Senior Infants class, the infants gathered at a table together to do a craft for Pink Shirt Day. The infants were observed coloring and using red and pink glitter stickers to decorate their shirt. In the 2-year-old classroom the children were eager to show Licensing Staff their new foam blocks. The children climbed and jumped off the blocks while others brought a firetruck and tractor to push down the foam ramp. The children laughed and clapped as they watched the vehicles go down the ramp.

The 3-year-old class was observed having a dance party before having afternoon snack. The children found musical instruments to play along with the music. The Educators were observed dancing and singing along with the children. All classes were observed having afternoon snack. Hand washing was observed before the children sat to eat. In the 4-year-old class, the Educator read "I See, I See" By R. Henderson and "If You Take a Mouse to School." as the children ate. Once all classes had finished eating, the children were observed preparing to go outside for end of day. Families were greeted as the children got picked up and attendance records were updated.

General Comments

Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Educators were attentive to the needs of the children and were heard praising their accomplishments, "Look at you! I'm proud of you!". Current learning stories, pictures of the children and their peers and artwork was displayed in each classroom and near the cubbies.
