General Comments

Upon Licensing Staff arrival, children were playing outside. Children were observed playing with balls, swings, trucks, a mud kitchen, a sand box and toys, tires and searching for insects. Imaginative play was observed and Educators were engaged and offered kind words of encouragement when playing.

The outdoor play area was well shaded with trees and a shade sail. Children were enjoying the different surface levels of play such as pea gravel, a tree house platform structure and climbing ramp.

The transition between outdoor play and lunch time was observed. The educators brought the children inside in their individual groups to wash their hands and get ready for lunch.

Lunch time was observed for all age groups. Educators were involved asking the children questions about their lunch and offered assistance when needed.

Childrens artwork is displayed in all age group rooms. Daily routines and learning stories were also posted. The 2-year-old, 3-year-old and 4-year-old rooms had activity stations to learn about ocean life, different insects such as bumblebees, and dinosaurs. The afterschool age children were planning different Christmas in July activities and crafts. Each room had books, toys, games, craft supplies and learning and free play material.

During the 2- and 3-year-old nap times, the facility as a whole was calm and quiet. Children were playing with opened ended material such as beads and pipe cleaners, wooden pieces for making towers and an ice cream shop.

Staff and child files were check and verified. Emergency evacuation and fire drill records are maintained and up to date.

Licensing staff recommends for licensing pending Health Inspection.
