<p>General Comments</p> <p>This preschool environment is clean and inviting. There are many materials and resources available to the children allowing sufficient quantity to allow freedom of choice. The children were very engaged with the educators and activities presented to them. A routine has evidently been established and the program appears to run smoothly.</p> <p>. The educators demonstrated positive child guidance such as gentle reminders, encouragement and positive reinforcement. They are very kind and loving towards the children. A good rapport between the educators and children is very evident.</p> <p>All incidents are being documented however upon review of the details of one incident it was discussed with the educator that it should have been reported to the Department. The educator stated that the parent was called and the parent took the child to the hospital but because they did not stay at the hospital, the educator did not feel that it needed to be reported. Any time a child is taken to a hospital or an incident that happens is questionable, please ensure that the Department is notified within 24 hours. The government forms must be</p>
