During my visit, the children were getting ready for their naps, and I noted that ratio was maintained in each room. I was screened upon arrival to the center, and they appear to follow the COVID guidelines well. I had a conversation with the operator about the procedures they have put into place. The parents do pick ups and drop offs from their cars in the front of the building during the colder temperatures. The children are separated into their bubbles and the relief staff remain as constant as possible within each bubble. The outdoor area has enough space for all the children to go outside at the same time while still maintaining their bubbles and keeping the routines of each classroom consistent. The program appears to be operating well. I will return to spend more time in each classroom at a future visit.
