Comments: During nap time in the 2-year-old room, ratio was 11 children for 1 educator. The child-to-staff ratio for children in a group may be reduced by one-half for napping children provided that one staff member is present in the same room as the children. The educator in the room shared that one child wakes at 1pm and moves over to the 3-year-old group. Deficiency was corrected as ratio became 10:1 at that time. Discussion was had with directors and plan is in place to ensure that ratio is met during nap time.			

General Comments
Visit to facility to complete annual inspection. Ratio was respected during the visit.
Upon arrival, the infant, 2-year-old, and 4-year-old groups got dressed and went outside to play. Meanwhile, the 3-year-old group and the Little Learners group had their snack (bagels) and engaged in free play. Afterward, all groups came inside to prepare for lunch. I observed educators completing diaper changes and assisting children with handwashing. Once lunch was finished, the infants and 2-year-olds settled down for a nap, while the older preschoolers went back outside. No school-aged children were present, as they were attending school.
Facility meets requirements under the Act and regulations; license will be recommended.
