General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site to complete the renewal inspection. The ratio was respected during the inspection.

The QAM observed an expired EpiPen in a classroom. The QAM had a discussion with the administrator to transmit the information to the parents in order for them to bring a new EpiPen.

While doing the renewal inspection, the children were observed eating their breakfast and playing in the indoor play area. Two classrooms also had parents visiting for the day. The Quality Assurance monitor observed the children playing with the educators, in one classroom the educator sang song and engaged the children in movements with the songs. The children were also observed transitioning to the outdoor play area before and after eating lunch. A group of children were observed sleeping while the others went to play outside. Positive interactions were observed between the educators and the children.
