## **General Comments**

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the follow-up inspection. The children were outside engaging in outdoor play activities on the large playground located at the side of the building.

The children went in for snack shortly after licensing staff arrived. The children washed up and had their snack. While the children were gathering their lunchboxes, one child's lunch box opened up as they were walking to the table to sit down. The child became upset. One of the educators went over to the child and helped them use self-regulating redirection techniques to help the child calm so they could eat their snack. Well done!!!

While observing in the classroom after snack, licensing staff saw multiple pieces of artwork, as well as, some plants that the children planted. The plants have grown since licensing staff conducted the first inspection visit.

After snack, the children had their pool time. The children were very excited to go to the pool!
