### General Comments

- Late afternoon visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- Ratio was respected during the visit
- All children's files have been checked, profile and consent are all completed in due form
- The operator and relief staff have a valid first aid certificate
- Major incident report was reviewed with the operator on what incident is considered reportable and which one is not.
- Minor incident reports are maintained in the child's file
- No medicine other than Tylenol is kept on site
- The operator facilitates children's learning by engaging in play and asking open-end questions.
- Children's indoor play area is safe and clean
- Each child has an easily accessible space to store their personal belongings, which is labeled with their name and used only for the intended child.
- Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key and are inaccessible to children
- It was observed during the visit that open end questions are asked to children guiding them towards problem solving to find a solution together.

Observations: Children arrived from school and went on the back patio, snack was provided to them (rice cake, goldfish and pudding) some ate while others started to work on their pumpkin digging and carving. When I was leaving children were still working on their pumpkin.
