General Comments						
Upon arrival I was screened, my temperature was taken, and I was logged in. The center is continuing to follow all COVID guidelines well.  Today I arrived before nap time for the younger preschool children. They were transitioning from lunch time to nap time. I spent a brief amount of time in the 2/3's room and noted lots of documentation and children's work on the walls, and I noted new paintings the children had done that morning that were drying. I spoke to the educators briefly about their planning and documentation and they seem to be doing a good job. They plan by taking onto account the children's interests, which is in line with the NB Curriculum Framework. I observed that the cots the children napped on were spaced appropriately throughout the room.  After lunch, the 4's were reading books. They were listening to stories and seemed to enjoy this. All the children seemed to be very interested in this activity and they knew the author and illustrator of their favorite books! I observed a variety of materials in the room for the children to play with.  The infant room also had a variety of age-appropriate materials for the children. I saw learning stories up in the hallway and I saw the infant's art work up on the walls. The educator was actively involved in activities with the infant, and was quick to meet the infant's needs. They went outside to play during my visit.  At the time of my visit, the program appeared to be running very well.
