General Comments

It was a very warm day when licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility. The expected temperatures for expected today will reach 37 degrees Celsius with the humidex. All of the children played outside as they will be inside for the afternoon to stay out of the heat.

The infants were playing outside when licensing staff arrived. The educators were observed cuddling the babies who needed cuddling. The infant playground, in the afternoon, is almost fully shaded, and was nice and cool while the infants were engaging in outdoor play.

while observing in the preschool 4/5 classroom the educator was observed reading multiple books with the children. Some of the books read to the children were: "Clean Cloths" (by Robert Munsch), "Deep Snow" (by Robert Munsch), "Get Out of Bed" (by Robert Munsch), "All By Myself" (Mercer Mayer), "Me Too" (by Mercer Mayer). The children were very engaged and interactive with the educator during story time.

Licensing staff observed an abundance of evidence of learning posted on the walls in every classroom, distinct learning centres and an lots of play materials for the children to engage with. Each classroom had a mud kitchen on their outdoor play area which had actual pots and pans, bowls, plates, spoons, etc., for the children to play with while engaging in dramatic play at the kitchen.

Please ensure that all infant bottles are labelled in the fridge.

Licensing staff also noticed two screws (blunt end out) were protruding from the wooden spool and will need to be removed. Licensing staff also noted the wooden bridge, located on the infant playground, has a broken board and a nail was exposed (not the sharp end) and will need to also be removed.

On the day of the monitoring inspection visit, everyone was staying cool!
