### General Comments

Upon Licensing staff arrival, the Operator and Educator were arriving with the children from school pick up.

The group of children gathered in the outdoor space to discuss their school day and play freely. After a free play, the group was divided in two, K-2 and grade 3-5. The K-2 children proceeded indoors for lunch while the 3-5 group stayed outdoors to play. Once indoors, belongings were hung up on hooks and proper handwashing was observed. During lunch, the K-2 children sat together at the table and were observed discussing summer plans. After the K-2 group finished eating, lunch bags were put away and the table was cleaned. The transition between indoor groups was smooth. The grade 3-5 children came indoors to eat their lunch and then were observed finishing up a Father's Day craft and building with Lego.

The outdoor space was inviting with ample shade from large trees. Throughout the inspection, children were observed playing in the sand box, in a wooden look-out-station/playhouse, skipping, playing with hula hoops, baseball, and building towers with milk crates. The Operator and Educator were actively engaged with the children in conversation and play. Positive child guidance was observed and positive words of encouragement were heard.

During inspection, there was evidence of a daily routine as transition times throughout the afternoon were smooth. The Operator and Educator were attentive to the children's needs. The environment was caring and there was evidence of child led play. Child and staff files were verified, and all required licensing documentation was present. The parent board in the entry way was organized, monthly fire drills are being completed and the daily attendance forms were in order. A discussion occurred with the Operator concerning carrying Epi-Pens for school pick up and excursions. It was agreed upon that Epi-Pens will be placed in the backpack each day and then back in the accessible First Aid cupboard.

Licensing staff recommends for renewal.
