<p>Comments: Sensory water bin set out for children - unclean - food remnants stuck to the sides. QA Monitor asked about this during inspection and it was stated that the bin is used for dirty dishes. Ensure sensory bin and dishes bin are separate. QA Monitor brought this to site coordinator's attention and the bin was immediately removed.</p> <p>Senior Group - art table - unclean - it was observed that food and garbage from lunch were left on the table where children were working on art. Tables must be cleaned before and after meals and snacks.</p>

<p>Comments: Senior Group: Art Area - unorganized and cluttered. To be decluttered and set up in a way that invites children to create and engage. Broken materials and worn out mark making materials to be removed and replaced. Board Game Shelf - cluttered and unorganized. To be decluttered and set up in a way that encourages children to engage in game play. Board games to be removed that are no longer of interest to the children.</p> <p>QA Monitor discussed ways to display materials within art area and board game area, that creates opportunities for children engage with materials and peers.</p>			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection: March Break - Full Day Program:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in outdoor play, indoor play and end of day routine this afternoon.</p> <p>Senior Group: Engaged in ball hockey and tumbling/cart wheels on mat set up for gross motor play. This group had been to the hockey rink to watch some hockey this morning, as this is an ongoing interest with this group of children. Educator had invited some children to help sand kitchen cupboard doors during inspection. Educator was observed modeling and encouraging children to use tools safely.</p>

General Comments

Middles Group:

Children engaged in outdoor play during inspection this afternoon. The indoor learning environment was set up with materials and activities that respond to the children's current interests.

Discussed with educator - adding a binder to the environment that includes documentation of the children's learning and experiences. Children can use this binder to revisit their experiences.
