### General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival the children were finishing up morning snack. As they finished, the children were preparing to transition to the outdoor playground. A final headcount was observed before the group went outside, and an Educator stayed inside to sanitize the tables from snack time.

Educators were well spread out on the playground, ensuring all areas were supervised. In one section an Educator was observed playing basketball and throwing the football to a group of children. In another section, a group of children asked to bring strings outside to make bracelets. An Educator sat with this group and was observed laughing with the children, asking about their plans for the weekend and making bracelets with them. The playground has a play structure, swings, playhouses, basketballs, picnic benches and a mud kitchen with bowls, cups, spoons, muffin trays for the children to play with.

Positive Child Guidance along with praise "Great job waiting!" "Thank you for checking if your friend was okay" was observed throughout the visit. Educators used clear communication with one another and were actively engaged with the children during the Monitoring Inspection.

During the Inspection, a child fell off the outdoor spinner on the playground. Educators rushed to the child, checking them over for any marks and sat with the child for several minutes offering comfort and hugs. Shortly after the child was observed on the swings. An Educator filled out an Incident Report and the child's parent/guardian was notified of the Incident.

As a reminder, please ensure the playground is being cleaned daily, prior to use, and at the end of the day. Licensing Staff observed several used Band-Aids, an empty disposable coffee cup, used socks and broken toys that had been left out overnight. An Educator was observed cleaning the garbage up during the visit.
