<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Visit to the facility for a monitoring inspection. - Ratio was respected during the visit. - Medications are locked and inaccessible to children, records need to be kept for each child when medication is administered. Appendix 6 administration of medication consent and record form needs to be filled for an ongoing treatment. - Easily accessible space must be provided for personal belongings such as blankets and pillows, the container or the bag must be labeled with the name of the child and stored separately for each child. - Daily incident log is maintained; parents are advised of the incident and signs the daily log.

General Comments

- Educators were engaged with children during activities.
- Learning stories posted highlights children's recent learning and interests.
- Children's guidance is made a respectful and positive way.
- There is a puddle of water into the outdoor space, administrator is in contact with employees from the town to get the big snowbank moved so the manhole will be exposed and let the water drain easier. In the meantime, the children are only playing in the section where there is pea gravel.

Observations: Children were playing outside when I got at the center, they came in and went into free play; playdoh, blocs, drawing and pretend play. When I left they were getting ready for lunch.
