Comments: One educator's First aid and CPR certificate is not valid. The educator must register for an approved First Aid course. The date of the scheduled course must be provided to the inspector, along with proof of valid certification once the course is completed.

Comments: Children did not participate in outdoor play during the morning. Outdoor play must be provided for at least one hour within each four-hour block of time when the majority of children receiving services are in attendance- weather permitting.

Comments: The monthly fire drill checklist was not completed in February or March as required. A fire drill must be conducted as soon as possible. Once completed, a copy of the completed fire drill checklist must be submitted to the inspector.

Educators are on track to have necessary PL hours completed by the licence expiry date of May 31st, 2026. A copy of PL hours record will be sent to inspector once they are completed.</p> <p>The 2 groups of preschool children participated in planned group activities and then free play. They washed their hands and had lunch. No school aged children were present at time of inspection.</p>
