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General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the Facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the children were engaged in a variety of activities. At the main tables one Educator was sitting with a small group of children playing with Play-Doh. Several Play-Doh accessories such as rolling pins, butterfly and bear cookie cutters were available for the children to use. The children were observed rolling their playdoh into balls and showing one another. Another group of children were playing with a light/water table. A variety of plastic birds such as an eagle, a parrot and a turkey as well as feathers, scoops and jumbo eyedroppers were observed in the water table. The children laughed as the scooped the water and played with the materials.

Gentle reminders and a visual timer was set before the group cleaned up for morning snack time. The tables were sanitized and hands were washed before the children sat down to eat. This morning the children had muffins, raspberries, blackberries, clementines, apple sauce and milk or water. The Educators sat with the children as they ate and offered more snack to those who had finished theirs. After snack time, the group gathered together to read "The Very Hungry Caterpillar." Once the story was over, some children explored other activities throughout the classroom while a few stayed and listened to another book.

Several positive changes have been made since the last Monitoring Inspection. A new kid friendly fireplace, a bubble fish tank and light cubes have been added to the classroom. An Educator stated three new children just recently joined. The children appeared to be comfortable in the environment, routine and with the Educators. Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Educators were observed guiding and supporting the children during conflicts and offering assistance as needed. Artwork, family pictures and current learning stories were observed throughout the classroom.
