The daily incident log is well-maintained, and monthly emergency evacuations are conducted and posted. The daily routine is clearly posted in each room, and evacuation procedures are prominently displayed and easily accessible. The environment reflects the interests of the children, with books selected to match their curiosities and children's artwork prominently displayed at their eye level. The learning and play areas throughout the

facility are well-defined, and children's creations can be seen throughout the space.

Traffic areas are kept clean and organized, and outdoor walkways are free of clutter. All toxic products, such as chemicals and cleaners, are kept locked and inaccessible. The diaper-changing area is located within one meter of a sink, and the diaper-changing procedures are clearly posted for staff to reference. Drinking water is readily available to children throughout the day. The infant outdoor play area is used separately or at different times than that of the older children, and the outdoor stationary equipment is surrounded by protective surfacing of an appropriate depth.

Several forms of documentation were observed throughout the facility, capturing the children's learning and interests. Educators intentionally extend curriculum outdoors and make efforts to bring elements of the natural world into the classroom. Webs have been developed with the children, allowing their interests and questions to be expanded upon collaboratively with educators.
