Comments: An educator was observed not implementing positive child guidance practices. The educator was heard making the following statements to a child: "Did you just drink all of that? You were already told about this!" "No!" "Sit!" "No, sit!" Following this interaction, a child sustained an injury. While the child was visibly upset and crying, the educator was heard saying, "How'd that feel?" The inspector spoke with the on-site Administrator regarding the observed incident. The Administrator immediately entered the classroom to provide support to the Educators. Educators are to review Section 8.2, Child Guidance of the Operator's Manual.			

General Comments
Renewal Inspection: Upon licensing arrival, infants and preschool children were observed gathered for a fire safety presentation. Two firefighters were present and spoke to the children. The firefighters brought their gear for the children to examine. Infant Educators were observed reading stories and singing songs with the infants. The infants were also observed looking out the window at the firetruck, playing with dolls, and engaging with play food. Preschool classrooms were observed playing outside with a variety of materials, including hammocks, wheelbarrows, shovels, coloring supplies, climbing structures, and mud kitchens. Indoors, preschool children were observed singing, dancing, coloring, playing with blocks, using dress-up clothing, and participating in imaginative salon play. Transitions in all rooms were observed to run smoothly. Classrooms were observed transitioning outdoors,

washing hands, meal and naptime routines. The classroom environments were calm, with all areas containing age-appropriate materials placed at the children's level and open for exploration throughout the day.

The on-site Administrator was observed supporting staff when needed.

The following records were reviewed: Incident logs, fire drills, educator professional learning hours, infant toddler daily sheets, and daily attendance sheets.

All staff files were viewed, and a random review of the children files was completed.
