Comments: While verifying a new staff member's file, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the social development verification was missing. Each staff member must obtain a social development verification before employment. The staff member in question had to leave the facility and can only return on-site once she receives the social development verification. An extra staff member went into the classroom to respect the child-to-staff ratio. Once the facility receives the social development verification, a copy can be sent to the Quality Assurance Monitor by email.

Comments: While taking the ratio upon arrival, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed 15 children in a classroom that only measures for 8 children. Each child must have 3.25m ² of indoor play space. The children transitioned to the outdoor play area and once upon return to the indoor play area the children were separated in two classrooms respecting the indoor play area measurements. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observes bottles of children Benadryl that belong to the facility. The Quality Assurance Monitor asked the person in charge if this belongs to a child or to the facility. The person in charge informs the Quality Assurance Monitor that it belongs to the facility, and it is only administered with the consent of the parent. The facility can only provide acetaminophen (Tylenol) . Other medications need to be provided by the parents. The Benadryl was removed from the medication cabinet. Deficiency is now compliant.			

General Comments The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site in the morning to conduct a monitoring inspection. The child-to-staff ratio was respected during the inspection. The following elements were verified:

General Comments

- Daily routine
- Rest area
- Washrooms
- Storage space
- Personal belongings
- Diaper changing
- Health
- Medications

The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the responsible staff member regarding designation requirements. The responsible staff member confirmed that the Quality Improvement plan is current, and confirmed that the 10 hours of professional learning for this renewal year is in progress.

The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with educators and the person in charge regarding children sleeping more than 2 consecutive hours. With the parent's written consent, the children can sleep for more than 2 consecutive hours if needed. The Quality Assurance Monitor gave a recommendation to create a consent to the parents in order to give consent for their child to sleep for more than 2 consecutive hours.

The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children playing in the indoor play area before doing the transition to eat their morning snack (lunch boxes). The children transitioned to the outdoor play. One classroom of children was observed at their garden area planning on what vegetable will be planted in the next coming days. The children were observed looking and smelling the new pink flowers. The educator found a spider wondering in the garden, the children showed interest in the spider. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the educators were dressed appropriately for the weather for outdoor play time with the children. One classroom was observed going on a morning walk into the wooded area. The children that transitioned to the indoor play area to do their washroom routine before having lunch (lunch boxes). One educator was observed signing songs with the infants before nap time. The children transitioned for nap and quiet time. Positive interactions were observed between the educators and the children.
