<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Visit completed in the afternoon for a monitoring inspection. - Ratio was respected during the visit. - Positive child guidance was witnessed during the visit. - The parent board at the entrance of the facility has all required documents posted. - Administrative records maintained on-site. Monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills are to be completed

monthly.

- A daily incident log is maintained. Parent is advised of incidents and signs the daily log.
- The facility has the proper number of functioning and available toilets and sinks. Children are always supervised when using the washroom. One potty chair and or training seat is provided. Steps or platforms are provided to allow children to reach toilets or sinks.
- The facility has a designated rest area. The minimum space between rest equipment is at least 46 centimetres. All nap equipment is washable and non-absorbent.
- Each child has its own individual space to put their belongings.
- Observations:
Infant room: Naptime and free play was witnessed during the visit. The educators were engaged in the children's play and sang songs with them.
2-3-year-olds: Naptime was witnessed during the visit.
- Discussion with the educators concerning incident reports, documentation and planification, cleaning products and personal belongings.
