## **General Comments**

When I arrived the two classrooms were getting ready to go outside.

The indoor classrooms are clean and well organized. The rooms are divided in different learning stations. The materials available to the children provide opportunities to explore various form of literacy, express creativity, and interests, explore arts and sciences, opportunity for individual and group experiences and problem-solve. There is also natural materials, open ended materials, and loose parts. All materials are easily accessible to children on lower shelves, clean and in good repair.

Positive child guidance was observed such has encouragements, gentle reminders, and positive reinforcement. Staff were also observed talking to children at their level and providing comfort when needed. Staff were also observed encouraging children to use good manners such as saying please and thank you.

There are learning stories and children's art on the walls and evidence of purposely planned programing.

Lunch was served around 11:30. Today was meatballs, rice and vegetables. During lunch the staff helped the children as needed and seconds were offered if children were still hungry. The older children in the classroom downstairs did grace together before eating lunch. After lunch the younger children upstairs had a nap while the older one's downstairs read some books.

The outdoor space has different surfaces such as grass, rocks, and mulch. There are different areas that allow for different types of play. Everything is in good repair and meets regulation.

Everything is in compliance; I recommend for renewal.
