<p>General Comments</p> <p>The children were playing outside upon my arrival. There are many learning centres set up in the outdoor play area and children remained engaged in what they were doing. Children were playing in sand, had access to water, and had access to a table where they could color uncooked pasta. The educators have used old tires to grow gardens and encourage the children to explore the natural environment. The opportunities for learning are very apparent in both the inside and outside environments. The staff are using a variety of methods to document the children's growth and learning. Examples of this include learning stories, the children's framed artwork, and</p>

children directed growth charts.

Educators engage with the children at their level and take interest in what the children are doing. Children are encouraged to have conversations and to share their thoughts and opinions. Redirection is used as needed but problems in the environment were rarely seen.

Please note that moving forward any toxic products and medication must be under lock and key. Child safety locks are no longer approved by the Department.

The administrator was on vacation today. The go-to person stated that there was another load of sand coming to the outdoor play space. There appeared to be enough sand by the outdoor play structure however it would need to be raked frequently where the children are digging and wearing the area down where they play the most.
