Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the administrator advised the inspector that 1 of the 2 buses is waiting on a part to repair the passenger door. The operator shall not use this bus until it is in compliance with the Motor Vehicles Act.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that daily activities are purposely planned and documented in all the classrooms. Deficiency is now compliant

27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (b) permitting, in the case of illness or soiled clothing, the child to shower or bathe or showering or bathing the child.	27(b)	Oct 26, 2022	Nov 22, 2022
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that consent for bathing or showering in the event of illness or soiled clothing is present in the 5 child files verified. Deficiency is now compliant.			
27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (j) permitting photographs and videos to be taken of the child for publication or social media.	27(j)	Oct 26, 2022	Nov 22, 2022
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that consent for permitting photographs and videos of child for publication or social media is present in the 5 child files verified. Deficiency is now compliant			
27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (k) posting photographs of the child at the licensed facility to illustrate the child's learning.	27(k)	Oct 26, 2022	Nov 22, 2022
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that consent for posting photographs of the child in the centre to illustrate learning is present in the 5 child files verified. Deficiency is now compliant.			
33(2) Stationary equipment in the outdoor play area shall be surrounded by a protective surfacing and installed according to the manufacturer's instructions.	33(2)	Oct 28, 2022	Nov 22, 2022
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that protective surfacing had been replenished around stationary equipment. Deficiency is now compliant.			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	Oct 26, 2022	Nov 22, 2022
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that 15 out of 15 water bottles verified are labelled with the child's name. Deficiency is now compliant.			
45(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall require a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility to (b) indicate whether the absence is due to illness or otherwise.	45(1)(b)	Oct 25, 2022	Nov 22, 2022
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that the reason for absences is indicated on daily attendance sheets in all the classrooms. Deficiency is now compliant.			
48(5) If more than one bottle-fed infant is receiving services at a licensed facility, the operator shall ensure that each bottle is (a) labelled with the child's name, (b) used only for the intended child.	48(5)	Oct 25, 2022	Nov 22, 2022
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that all the infant bottles stored in the fridge are labelled with the child's name. Deficiency is now compliant.
