22 The daily routine of a licensed facility shall include (b) a period of rest for a length of time that meets the needs of each infant and preschool child receiving services at the licensed facility but that does not exceed two consecutive hours unless there is a written request from a child's parent or guardian to extend the length of time.	22(b)	Jun 15, 2026	
Comments: The administrator informed the Quality Assurance Monitor that one child often sleeps for more than 2 hours. As per regulations, rest periods must not exceed 2 consecutive hours. However, families may request an exception to meet the individual needs of the child. In this case, written consent from the family must be kept in the child's file. The administrator may send a copy of the consent to the QAM to ensure compliance.			
28(2) An operator of a licensed facility shall carry out emergency evacuation and fire drills monthly.	28(2)	Jul 01, 2026	
Comments: During the inspection, the QAM noted that a fire drill was not completed for the month of May. Emergency evacuation drills must be done every month. The QAM advised the administrator that two fire drills will need to be completed in June to make up for the missed one. A photo of the record showing both evacuation drill can be sent to the QAM as proof.			
33(3) An operator of a licensed facility shall complete a monthly review and maintenance plan on all stationary equipment that includes the following information: (a) the review and repair dates; (b) the action required and the action taken; and (c) the name of the staff member who conducted the review.	33(3)	Jul 01, 2026	
Comments: During the inspection, the QAM noted that the review and maintenance plans for all outdoor stationary equipment were not completed for the months of April and May. A review and maintenance plan must be completed monthly for all stationary equipment and should include the review and repair dates, any actions required and taken, and the name of the staff member completing the review. The administrator may send the next completed review, which is expected soon, to the QAM by email to come back into compliance			

General Comments The Quality Assurance Monitor (QAM) conducted an on-site monitoring inspection. During the visit, the following elements were reviewed and verified: - Staff qualifications and training - Administrative records maintained on-site

General Comments

- Medication records
- Daily activities and routines
- Rest area
- Health and safety practices
- Transportation of children
- Child guidance practices

The QAM observed that the large stationary equipment in the outdoor play area remains inaccessible, as it has been blocked off since last summer pending repairs. The QAM reiterated the importance of ensuring children have access to all outdoor equipment, especially with the arrival of the summer months. The administrator advised that repairs are expected to be completed shortly and that the equipment will be made available to children real soon.

During the inspection, children were seen playing indoors, having snack, and playing outside. The QAM observed positive interactions between staff and children, such as educators getting down to the children's level to talk and engage with them.
