Comments: Upon licensing staff arrival, the cabinet under the sink with toxic products was not locked. Please ensure that it is locked at all times. Deficiency is now compliant.			

General Comments
Upon licensing staff's arrival for the renewal inspection, a portion of the after-school program children had arrived and were engaged in outdoor play. The remaining children soon arrived by bus. Attendance was taken as the children lined up to enter the facility and store their belongings on their designated hooks. Once inside, the educator informed the children that they could either have snack at the tables or choose an activity area where they wished to play. Children were observed washing their hands prior to eating snack. The program is organized into several activity areas, each offering different types of play and materials. Areas include, but are not limited to, creative activities, dramatic play, doll houses, construction materials such as LEGO and Minecraft blocks, and literacy materials. Children use personalized keychains with their names to indicate which room they have selected. The rooms areas are arranged in an open-concept layout without doors separating the spaces, allowing educators to maintain supervision throughout the environment as they move between the different areas. Children were observed participating in a variety of activities, including drawing, building with LEGO and Minecraft-themed blocks, playing with dollhouses, colouring, beading, engaging in dramatic play, and reading. Throughout the inspection, educators were observed interacting with children during their activities and responding to children's needs. Positive child guidance practices were observed throughout the visit. Staff and children's files were reviewed and found to be in compliance with licensing requirements. Licensing staff recommends the program for renewal.
