General Comments						
Upon Licensing staff arrival, all classrooms were finishing lunch. With the hot weather, the children stayed indoors for the afternoon and enjoyed tabletop activities and free play. Each classroom was organized and inviting. Children's artwork was on display and play material such as wooden blocks, books, loose play pieces and art supplies were in good condition. Educators in each classroom were observed playing with the children at their level and offering positive words of encouragement. Positive child guidance was also observed in each classroom and transition times between activities were smooth. There is evidence of daily routine and planning as the posted theme on the parent board corresponded with the activities. In the afternoon, classrooms were observed playing with water sensory bins containing bubbles and orbeez, colouring, creating perler bead shapes, felt story boards, wooden blocks, and Lego. Educators were actively engaged and offered ample clean up time with gentle reminders before changing activities. During inspection, the outdoor play space was not being used due to extreme heat although play material such as balls, a mud kitchen, shovels, scoops, dinosaurs and whale sprinkler were in good condition. A new inclusive playground has been added to the outdoor space since last inspection with swings, a sensory wall and an accessible merry-go-round. Staff and child files were verified, and all required documentation was present. Monthly fire drills and playground maintenance checks are being completed as well as daily attendance. Children's personal belongings were neat and tidy and water bottles were accessible.
