General Comments
<p>Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Families were greeted as the children arrived in the morning and tabletop activities were ready for the children. During the morning drop off period children were engaged in coloring, wooden puzzles, playing with cars and helping set up activities for later in the morning.</p> <p>In one of the 4/5-yearold classrooms, the children were eager to help the Educator prepare a Science Experiment that they would be doing later in the morning. A group of children were observed mixing glitter in with baking soda and using forks to stir it around. Another Educator in the room sat with a small group of children as they worked on a puzzle together. Once all the children had arrived in the classrooms, the children were observed cleaning up to prepare for morning circle time. The Educators and children sang a welcome song, and the children got to pick a few songs they would like to dance/sing along with.</p>

General Comments

Circle time was observed in all classrooms. The Educators were respectful of the children's attention span and interests. Hand washing was observed before the children sat together for morning snack. Once snack time was finished, children engaged in a craft before getting ready to go play outside. Several headcounts were observed as the children went from the classroom to the washroom and from the classroom to outside. The children appeared familiar with the morning routine which allowed for smooth transitions.

Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Educators were heard giving gentle reminders for walking feet, dancing and laughing with the children and offering hugs. The classrooms were organized and welcoming. Artwork, family pictures, and pictures of the children with peers were displayed throughout the classrooms and hallways. Monthly fire drills are being conducted.
