The children were eager to talk about Halloween and what they would be dressing up as. Once everyone had a turn explaining their costume, they lined up to wash hands for morning snack. As the children finished eating, they gathered on the carpet to play Pictionary. Today they were learning about the letter A. The Educator read "The Adventures of Abby Alligator" before the children did an alligator craft.

The transition from inside the facility to the outdoor play area was smooth. Water bottles were filled and brought outside along with attendance records and a First Aid kit. Allergies were posted in each classroom. Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection.
