General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the children in the larger class were engaged in a variety of activities. At one table a dollhouse was set up and a small group of children were sitting together playing with ponies and dolls. At another table, a group of children were building different creations using magnetic tiles. In the smaller classroom, some children were making bracelets using colorful beads and pipe cleaners. A group of children were excited to be having a play tea party. They were observed going back and forth to the play kitchen area to refill the teapot and carefully walk back to the table, pouring tea for their peers.

A clean up song was played, and the children were observed tidying up. Afterwards, the group gathered on the carpet and picked several songs to dance, jump and skip along to before sitting down to have a quick morning circle time. The children were eager to talk about Halloween and what they would be dressing up as. Once everyone had a turn explaining their costume, they lined up to wash hands for morning snack. As the children finished eating, they gathered on the carpet to play Pictionary. Today they were learning about the letter A. The Educator read "The Adventures of Abby Alligator" before the children did an alligator craft.

The transition from inside the facility to the outdoor play area was smooth. Water bottles were filled and brought outside along with attendance records and a First Aid kit. Allergies were posted in each classroom. Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Educators were actively engaged with the children throughout the morning and were heard offering praise and encouraging words, "I knew you could do it!" "I love how you did that, great job!".
